**Math**

Adjustment of 4-5 math program to allow for ease of instruction  
Additional PD with Everyday Math for 3,4,5 Math teachers  
PD for new CPM program for 6 Math teacher  
Introduction of Accelerated Math program and heterogeneous mixed-age grouping in 4-6  
Individualized learning plans for all students with Math CST at FB or BB including:  
    One on one support in the classroom  
    Homework Help 2 afternoons per week  
    Math Lab 2 afternoons per week for 10 sessions  
    SST meetings each trimester  
    Specific grouping strategies in CPM class work  
    Summer Camp Academic Bridge program

**ELA**

Continued focus on reading comprehension strategies in grades 2-3  
More systematic use of Leveled Reading Assessments across K-4  
Introduction of Thinking Maps training for K-6 faculty – focus on support for writing across curriculum for Common Core writing  
Individualized learning plans for all students with ELA CST at FB or BB including:  
    One on one support in the classroom  
    Homework Help 2 afternoons per week  
    SST meetings each trimester  
    Leveled grouping in literature circles to provide peer mentors  
    Attention to ELL needs through Thinking Maps, Visual Aids,  
        academic vocab focus, parent support (translation services, parent ed.  
        mtgs.)  
    Summer Camp Academic Bridge program

**For the future –**

The single most important factor in supporting our struggling learners is more time.

To address this need during the 2012-1013 year LCW has implemented the following support plans:

- Summer Academic Bridge program in conjunction with CPT with scholarships available through LCW and private funding
- Homework Help – afterschool assistance with homework for LCW MS on a sliding scale basis
- Math Lab – afterschool basic skills support in mathematics for grades 4-6 based on need and by invitation only funded by LCW

- Spanish-language parent education program – monthly meetings for Spanish speaking parents hosted by LCW native-Spanish speaking faculty member addressing curriculum, instruction, school programs and processes, etc.

LCW needs support to put in place a comprehensive After School Academic Support Program and consistent, long term summer Bridge Programs for students who are not succeeding.
